

Boggs Picks Angus Champions At Mid-South Fair

ST. JOSEPH, Mo. — Don Boggs, Brookings, S.D., judged the 100 head of Angus bulls and heifers at the 1994 Mid-South Fair Roll of

Victory (ROV) Angus Show held Sept. 26 in Memphis, Tenn.

In heifer competition, J Bar J Blackcap Miss topped the 68

entries to win grand champion laurels after topping the junior division. Jason Goff of Norwich, Ohio, and Green Knoll Farms, Malaga, Ohio, jointly own the winner that is an April 1993 daughter of Rally 661.

The reserve grand champion female was N P F Forever 5P3 owned by Jamie Sneed of Ewing, Ill. Sneed's entry first won reserve laurels in the junior division and is an April 1993 daughter of Siebrings All Pro 9110.

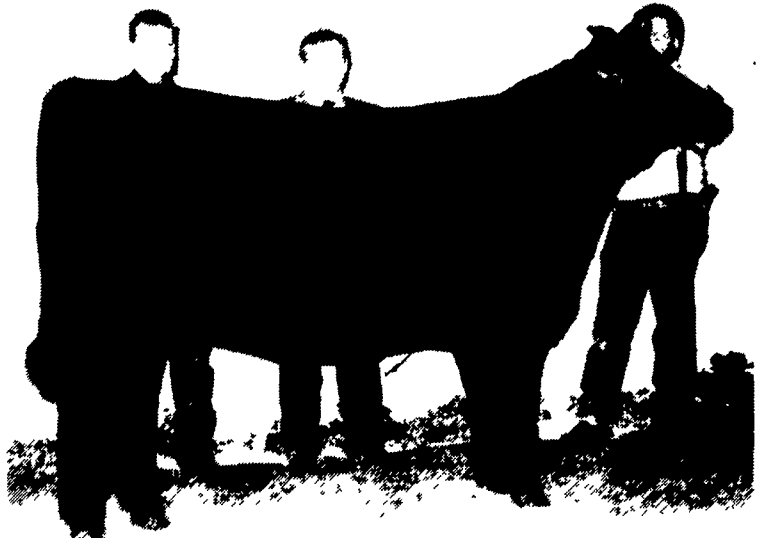
In the bull show, the grand champion was Cedarcrest Slammer 242, a June 1992 son of WSF Grand Slam. The entry is owned by Jeff Rhode of Kingston, Ill., and first topped the senior divisions.

The reserve grand champion bull was the reserve senior winner exhibited by Doug O'Dell of Clay City, Ill. The January 1992 bull is sired by Da Es Ro Casey 629 and is named Eldon.

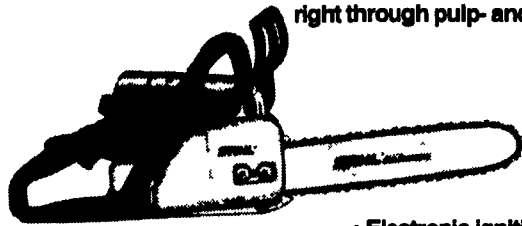

Farm Market Guides Available

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — As a result of a several-month survey and evaluation, the state Department of Agriculture (PDA) has completed and published a listing of 800 farm markets, roadside stands and pick-your-own farm operations throughout the state.

The guide became available October and copies have been sent to county Penn State Cooperative Extension offices, the PDA's seven regional offices, and to the 11 tourist "welcome" centers located around the state.

According to the PDA, the publication is an update of a previous listing, last completed in 1988.

PDA officials said that the current list is believed to be fairly comprehensive.

Questionnaires were sent out in March and an evaluation process on subsequent returned information was done. About 7,000 of the total 10,000 guides printed were distributed in September for public dissemination. Some extension offices contacted were already out of their initial allocation.

The guide can help the state's residents and visitors find quality food at the state's farm markets, according to state Agriculture Secretary Boyd Wolff.

"Pennsylvania's agricultural producers bring quality products from their homes to yours," Wolff said. "Our new guide will help consumers locate a wide selection of wholesome foods in their areas."

Although the 1994 growing season is over, many of farm markets offer much more than fresh fruits and vegetables.
