

# Montadale Show, Sale Held

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — The Montadale Breeders had their debut sale at the Keystone Show this year, and a good first impression they made.

The Mid-Atlantic area has become a top source for competitive Montadale genetics, with several breeders in that area showing and selling nationally competitive sheep. Their influence was strongly felt in this hot new sale.

The champion and top selling ewe, was on the first place ewe lamb consigned by Weston Farm, of Glen Arm, MD. This Grand

Design daughter from their show flock sold to Vanderwende Genetics, for the weekends top priced of \$1000. The Reserve Champion ewe also came from the tough ewe lamb class. She was consigned by the Cavey Family, of New Windsor, MD., and this triplet daughter of Grand Design brought a \$50 bid from Meghan Ried, Clear Spring, MD.

The next ewe to sell was the first place yearling ewe from Ron & Karen Ferguson of Fredonia, PA. This class winner sold for \$400 to

Sally & Kathryn Booth, Westminster, MD. A Weston Farm yearling ewe sold at \$500 to Thelma Kitzmiller, Wellsville, PA. However it was the third place ewe from Alexandria Drenning, that caused the most excitement in the yearling ewe class. This big ewe topped the yearling ewe prices at \$650 also going to the Booths. A pair of Pennsylvania ewes were next to sell with Sarah Williams of Honesdale, PA, taking a Breezeview (McCauley) ewe at \$350, and a Faith Acres (Pary) ewe sold for \$225 to Donald

Quigley, Keymar, MD.

Another Cavey ewe lamb sold to Zachary Reed, Newville, PA, for a \$325 bid. The next Ferguson ewe lamb sold for \$300 to Lynne Warner, of Lineboro, MD.

With over thirty buyers registered, from seven states it was easy to see that the interest was high for this

new Montadale sale. The buyers certainly appreciated the quality of the Montadale offering as the sale posted a strong \$488.88 average.

Dave Cook, New London, Ohio; judged the show and Bill McCauley, Aiglen, PA, auctioned the sale. The sale was managed by the Maryland Montadale Assoc.
