OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY

Compared to Last Week: Feeder steers and heifers \$1.00-\$2.00 higher. Steer calves \$2.00-\$4.00 higher; heifer calves \$3.00-\$5.00 higher. Trade active with very good demand for all grades and classes of feeder cattle and calves. Quality of the supply generally average. Yearling weights average to mostly full. Yearling flesh slightly thin to medium. Calf condition slightly thin to fleshy, however all types including fleshy soft calves participated in advances. Wheat pasture looking very good but moisture remains spotty and good general rain is needed. \$70.00 slaughter cattle and empty feedlot pens have spurred yearling market. Slaughter cows \$2.00-\$3.00 lower. Slaughter bulls \$2.00 lower. Packer demand light to moderate for cows and light for bulls.

Cows and bulls comprised 770 head of the supply with packers taking around 65 percent. Receipts this week 14,285; last week 8,882; last year 10,943. Supply consisted of 50 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs.; 45 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 5 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
