Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds improved in some instances, but remained seasonally light to fair overall. Seller offerings ranged adequate to ample and were generally more available on the heavier weight sizes. Live supplies were moderate, instances light; weights were mostly desirable to heay. Processing schedules were very heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 47 to 58 cents. Trade sentiment was generally steady. In the parts complex, inventories varied from plant to plant, but all items were fully sufficient for buyer needs.
