GRAIN AND SOYBEAN PRICES EXTENDED TUESDAY'S GAINS WITH EXPORT OPTIMISM THE MAJOR SUPPORTER. WHEAT 5 TO 9 CENTS HIGHER. CORN 2 TO 4 CENTS HIGHER. SOR-GHUM UNCHANGED TO 2 CENTS HIGHER. SOYBEANS 4 TO 8 CENTS HIGHER. GOOD EXPORT DEMAND THIS WEEK AND EXPECTATIONS OF POTENTIAL NEW SALES TO BE OFFERED TO EGYPT, PUSHED WHEAT PRICES HIGHER. REPORTS THAT CHINA MAY BE SEEKING AROUND 200 MILLION DOLLARS IN GSM-102 FUNDS, ALSO A POSITIVE FACTOR. CORN AND SOYBEAN PRICES CLIMBED HIGHER IN REACTION TO HIGHER WHEAT PRICES AND IMPROVED EXPORT INTERESTS. SOYBEAN PRICES JUMPED HIGHER DUE TO STRENGTH IN BEAN OIL AND LIGHT FARMER SELLING. HARVEST CONTINUED ACTIVE AS STORAGE SPACE AND TRANSPORTATION REMAINS A PROBLEM. THE MAJORITY OF BEANS ARE OUT OF FIELDS BUT UNMOUNTED CROPS COULD BE HELD OVER TO 1995 DUE TO LOW PRICES AND SHRINKING ELEVATOR ROOM.
