Mae B. Hostetter, 4-H agent in Armstrong County and Faye Sandsbury, assistant to the northeast regional director, have received the Distinguished Service Award. This award recognizes Extension Home Economists for leadership and implementation of well-planned programs with results and accomplishments. Over her 21 year career, Mae Hostetter has devoted her efforts to strengthening the 4-H home economics and leadership programs through volunteer development, not only in Berks, Dauphin, and Armstrong Counties, but also through providing program support to staff in 16 counties in Southeastern Pennsylvania. For five years, Mae had served in the role of regional program leader in 4-H/Youth Development.

Faye Sandsbury, a senior extension agent and doctoral candidate in adult education, focuses on development of agent and paraprofessional staff in the areas of program development, managing

change, strategic planning, program evaluation, and distance education in her role as assistant to the regional director. Major programming has concentrated on meeting the needs of an aging population through teaching extension agents, agency representatives, and volunteers, the VIP Program Senior Series, and housing needs.

Fay B. Strickler was elected to the office of vice-president for professional development of the National Association of Extension Home Economists. Fay will be responsible to provide a variety of professional development opportunities for extension professionals that focus on new issues and technology, interdisciplinary programming, and communication and marketing techniques, and actively seek and promote member involvement in annual sessions as planners, presenters, facilitators, and evaluators. Fay served as the national arrangements committee chair during 1994 and chair-elect during 1993 and she served as president of the Pennsylvania Association of Extension Home Economists during 1989-91.
