STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY

Compared to last week: Yearling steers and heifers firm to \$2.00 higher. Steer calves steady. Heifer calves \$1.00-\$2.00 higher. Demand good for yearlings. Demand moderate to good for calves. Weather was wet and cool after state wide 1/2 inch rain. Detrimental weather had no effect on calf market as wheat is ready to graze following this moisture. Yearling weigh-ups average to full with slightly thin to medium flesh. Several calf offerings in thinner short term weaned condition; bulk of calves in medium to fleshy condition. Slaughter cows \$1.00-\$2.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady to \$2.00 higher. Packer demand moderate, 800 cows and bulls sold with 35 percent replacements. Receipts this week 16,350; last week 14,327; last year 13,111. Supply consisted of 46 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs.; 49 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 5 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.
