



When stripping tobacco, please grade 3 ways. Color grade. Please watch your moisture when stripping. Tobacco companies are saying they need this crop. If you have hail cut tobacco, color grade and make neat bales - it pays! Keep green out.

STRIP YOUR TOBACCO EARLY!

609 tobacco companies are saying: get your crop on auction in December. They say they need PA 609 tobacco to blend with burley tobacco. This is good news for PA 609 as it is becoming known worldwide. Tennessee and Kentucky auctions open at Thanksgiving. Local tobacco farmers should bring some of their best tobacco to first sale, December 5th, with a full warehouse to attract buyers. There are reports tobacco buyers are telling tobacco companies in the south that they can buy cheaper on the farm. If this is true -- *think twice!*
