## IBP Challenges Industry To Assist NPPC In Promoting Pork

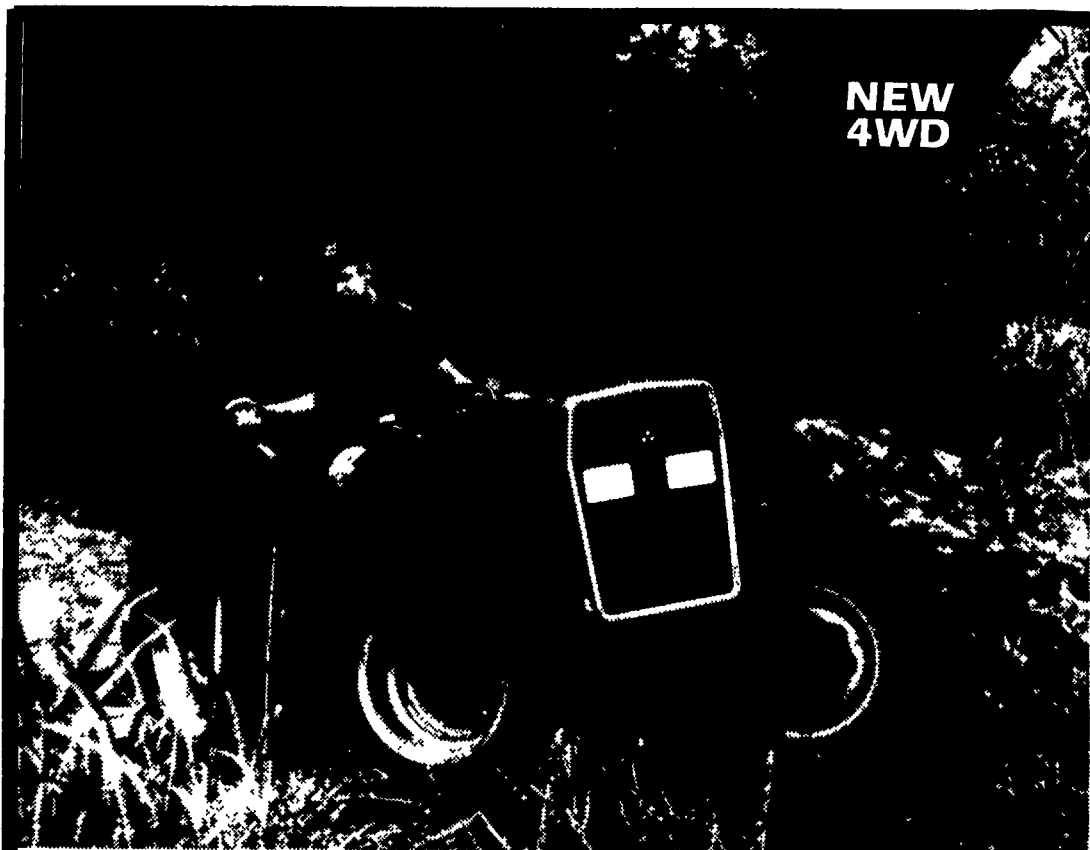
DES MOINES, Iowa — In response to an appeal by the National Pork Producers Council (NPPC) to the nation's packers, IBP, Inc., issued a challenge to the rest of the industry in a effort to promote increased pork consumption.

The Dakota City, Neb. — based company has agreed to contribute \$50,000 to the National Pork Producers Council, if all other sectors of the industry provide an additional \$100,000. The money would be used to support the current promotional efforts of NPPC to keep pork moving through the food chain during this period of large supplies.
