Compared to last week: Steers over 600 lbs. steady; feeder heifers steady to \$1.00 higher. Calves under 600 lbs. \$2.00-\$5.00 higher. Trade active. Demand very good for calves as wheat pastures are excellent. Calf quality plain to average, with modest end very attractive. Calf flesh attractive to buyers with majority of calves in slightly thin to medium flesh. Yearling demand good for light supply. Yearling quality plain to average with average to full weigh-ups and slightly thin to medium flesh. Slaughter cows \$1.00-\$1.50 lower. Slaughter bulls \$.75 lower. Demand light to moderate for packer cows and bulls. 880 cows and bulls sold with packers taking 35 percent. 300 hi quality Longhorn cows sold in special dispersal sale. Bulk of these

cows bred 4-6 months and in medium flesh. Last weekend's 2-3 inch statewide soaking rain put "icing" on early wheat pasture. More rain coming this week. Receipts this week 14,050; last week 16,069; last year 10,169. Supply consisted of 44 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs.; 50 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 6 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

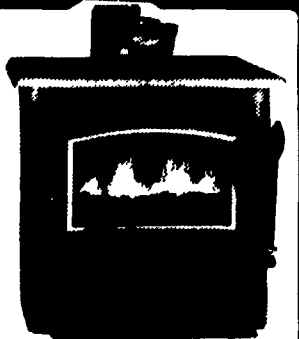
