

Cash Picks Junior Angus Winners At State Fair Of Va.

ST. JOSEPH, Mo. — Junior Angus breeders from throughout the state exhibited 38 head of Angus heifers at the State Fair of Virginia Junior Show in Richmond. Erskine Cash, University Park, Pa., judged the show.

In the owned heifer show, Jason Michael of Mt. Solon, Va., exhibited the grand champion female that first won the senior heifer calf division. She is named B&J Lady Chelsea and is an October 1993 daughter of Leachman Tonto.

Skyway Hills Rose 6807 was named reserve grand champion owned female after topping the junior heifer calf division. She is a January 1994 daughter of D H D Traveler 6807 and is owned by Justin Updike of Washington, Va.

In the bred-and-owned heifer show, Darren Eversole of Blacksburg, Va., exhibited the grand champion. She is named D M E Eulima Lady C2 and is a July 1993 daughter of Smithcrest Rito 1Z85.

The reserve grand champion bred-and-owned heifer was Tontos Black Jasmine owned by Linda Harris of Roanoke, Va. The May 1993 daughter of Leachman Tonto first won the reserve intermediate honor.

Horse Council To Sponsor Expo

ALLENTOWN (Lehigh Co.) — Many people who are interested in someday owning a horse don't know where to go for the horse sense. Taking lessons, attending hands-on clinics, and meeting other horse owners would help if the maverick knew where to start.

The Department of Agriculture's Extension Service or livestock columns in newspapers will probably know if there is a local (volunteer) horse council.

In eastern Pennsylvania, the oldest horse council in the state, the Lehigh Valley Horse Council (LVHC), was formed for the purpose of keeping local non profes-

sional horse owners up to date on various equine-related issues.

On November 19, the LVHC will sponsor its third annual Expo and Trade Fair at the Days Inn Conference Center at Routes 22 and 309. The program will consist of four professional lectures complemented by many trade and vendor displays. The registration fee at the door will be \$25.

This year, the first speaker will be Sue M. McDonnell, Ph.D. She will discuss equine behavior. Her work has received international recognition. She holds an honorary doctorate and gold medal from the University of Krakow for her work

with horses in Eastern Europe. She is on the faculty of the University of Pennsylvania Veterinary School, as head of the equine behavior program, and she was recently featured in Equus.

Other speakers will be Skip Kralick, project writer for the Da Vinci Horse, Inc.; Laurie Beim, director of communications from the United States Equestrian Team and executive assistant for the National Horse Show; and Karen Porter, Prestige Saddle and Harness, who will discuss saddle fitting.

During the past year, other LVHC clinics have addressed lameness, horse pastures and barn management, training and general health maintenance.

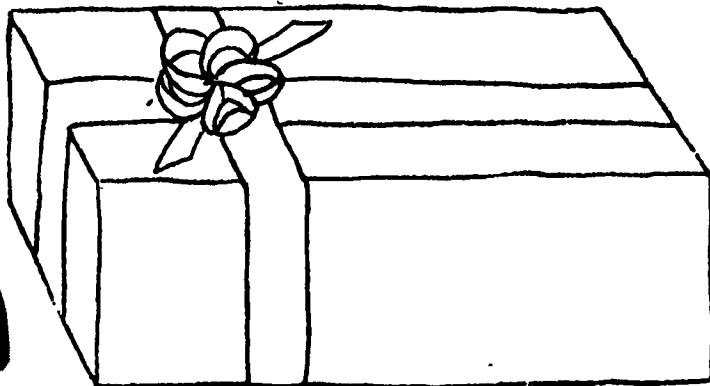

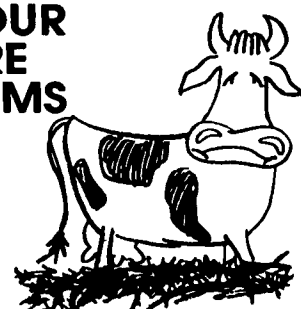
