PSU College Of Medicine, PDA Partners In Safety

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — The Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture and The Pennsylvania State University College of Medicine have formed a partnership to promote agricultural safety and health according to Agriculture Secretary Boyd E. Wolff.

The agreement calls for development of an Agromedicine Program through a comprehensive medical and education outreach effort.

"The two parties to this agreement have the support and cooperation of the Pennsylvania Department of Health and the Colleges of Agricultural Sciences and Health and Human Development. All have roles that advance

farm safety in Pennsylvania, and working together, they can make a very significant difference in this vital area," Wolff said.

"By working under a memorandum of understanding, we can minimize duplication of effort and confusion and best utilize our resources toward an important effort to make farming safer."

The initial program will target farm worker safety as it relates to the use of pesticides. This program will be under the direction of the College of Medicine at the Milton S. Hershey Medical Center.

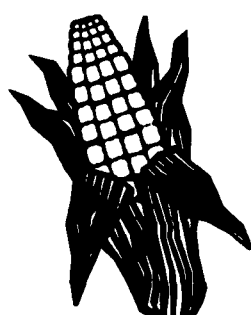
