Nply generally average, however conditions excellent for buyers. Calf flesh thin to medium, few slightly fleshy. Yearling flesh medium to mostly slightly thin. Weigh-ups generally average. Slaughter cows \$2.00-\$3.00 higher. Slaughter bulls \$5.00 higher. Cow and bull trade active with very good demand from packers. Slaughter cows normally move up in price at this time of year but rejection of some import beef helped drive the market additionally higher. Total of 221 cows and bulls sold with 75 percent to packers. 2-5 inches of rain covered the state over the weekend. Receipts this week 6,225; last week 14,416; last year 8,039. Supply consisted of 32 percent yearlings and calves over 600 lbs.; 64 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 4 percent cows and bulls.

To Host Educators From China

DOYLESTOWN, (Bucks Co.)— Delaware Valley College will host six visiting educators from northwest China for a study tour, entitled "Strengthening Agriculture Education in North-west China" from Nov. 27-Dec. 3.

The educators, from six colleges in China, will study the current status of technical and vocational education in agriculture, including rural economic development, the adoption of modern agricultural techniques, and the productive capacity of farmers in long-term development programs.

In addition, they will learn how to closer link what is taught in schools to the needs of the community by examining the need to modify special course content to encompass training in practical skills. The administration of a college, including the area of employment, finances, recruiting, records, development and curriculum, will be discussed as well.

Delaware Valley College Faculty and administration will assist the Chinese visitors in accomplishing their educational goals by presenting seminars and lectures focusing on the

"science with practice" approach to learning, which integrates a student's education into national, state, and local relationships with the agricultural industry. Also, the visitors itinerary includes a breakfast reception with the Central Bucks Chamber of Commerce on Nov. 30.
