Silent Auction Averages \$4,076

REYNOLDSBURG, Ohio—For the third consecutive year, a silent auction was held in conjunction with the All American activities Nov. 4-7 in Louisville, KY. The silent auction is held each November in conjunction with the

North American International Livestock Exposition and is managed by Jersey Marketing Service, an affiliate of the American Jersey Cattle Association. Buyers interested in bidding signed up with Jersey Marketing Service for buyer numbers.

After checking pictures and production information on the display for the silent auction, written bids were accepted from Friday evening, Nov. 4 until Monday evening, November 7 for the embryos being offered. Thirteen embryo lots

averaged \$4,076.92 with the top lot bringing \$6,800. Tim Billman, West Salem, Ohio, bid \$6,800 to purchase the consignment of Wayne Lutz, Mocksville, NC. Billman will select first choice female sired by Comfort Pal Adonis-ET, PTI +365 by Excellent-90 percent Sweet Grass 2875 Gurit-ET.

Gurit is a Highland Duncan Lester daughter with a record of 1-11 305 17,390 pounds milk, 956 pounds fat, and 620 pounds protein. There was a tie for the second high selling consignment, both bringing \$6,000. Hedgebrook Farm, Winchester, Va., bid \$6,000 to purchase the consignment of Kurt and Carol Alberti, Wendell, Idaho. Hedgebrook will select first choice female sired by Mason Boomer Sooner Berretta, PTI +495, by Excellent-90 percent Au Duncan Legend Topsy.

Topsy is a Highland Magic Duncan daughter with a record of 4-01 305 25,710 4.8% 1223 4.0% 1026. The resulting heifer will have a PA of +2331M, +101F, +90P, +315PS, +353CY\$, +3.7 Type, and +528 PTI. A consignment by James Chaney, Bowling Green, Ky., also brought \$6,000 and was purchased by John Kokoski, Hadley, Mass. Kokoski will select a first choice female sired by Duncan Duke of Glenwood, PTI +443, by Very Good-86% DJF Berretta Ida. "Ida" is a Mason Boomer Sooner Berretta daughter.
