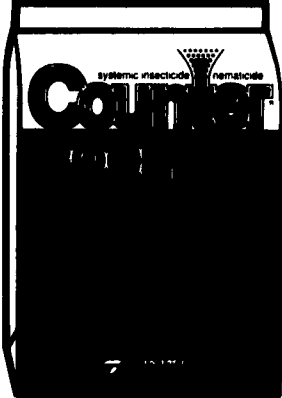


### Franklin Co. DHIA Presents Awards

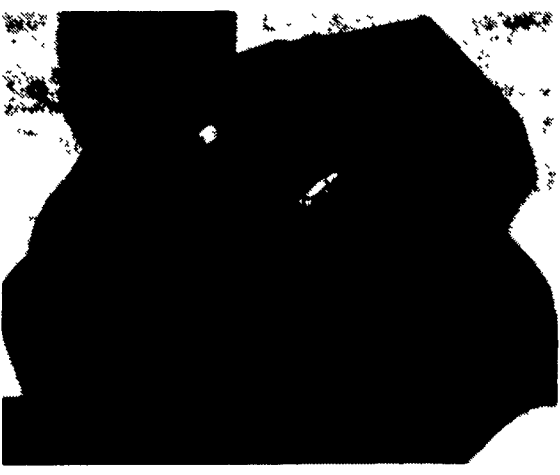

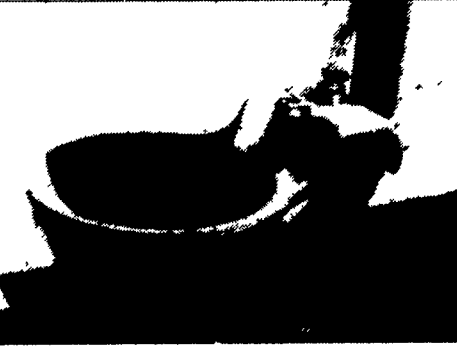
