Shell egg supplies were also adequate, and most plants planned reduced schedules through the end of the year. Liquid and frozen eggs processed under federal inspection in the Eastern region for the week ending December 17, 1994 were 6% less than last week, and 18% above the same week last year.

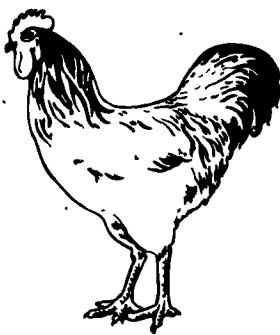

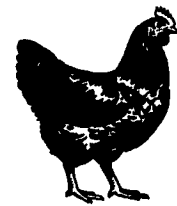

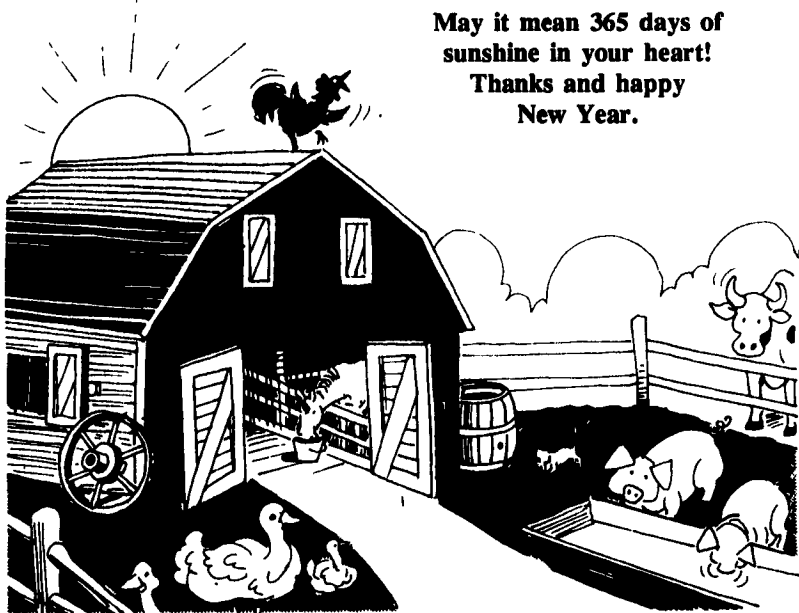
