No part of the emu is wasted. Fashionable leather handbags, boots, and apparel are made from the body hide. The skin from the legs has a dramatic reptilian texture, which fashion designers find a suitable substitute for hides from endangered specis. Emu feathers, eggs, and toenails are used for unique jewelry and crafts.

One of the most exciting products, Carol believes, is natural emu oil used in lotion, creams, perfumes, lip balm, and skin and hair products.

According to Carol, the emu has a layer of oil beneath its hide that does not penetrate the meat. An emu yields an average of 5 to 6 liters of natural oil. Emu oil is known to be penetrating and healing. Carol said a local high school uses it for athletes who receive muscle injuries, and people who use the oil say that it brings quick healing to bursitis, arthritis, and exema. In testing, a burn center

found that when emu oil is used on burns there is little or no scarring.

"Sometimes I feel like I'm selling snake oil," Carol said in reference to the reputation of snake oil being sold as a cure-all, "but emu oil really works."

Carol declines to say how much an emu costs since prices vary considerably depending on genetics and if it is a proven breeder pair.

"We call emu the 'turkey of the

'90s.'" Carol said. According to Carol, turkeys were first introduced into the area in the 1920s. At that time, turkeys were very expensive but have decreased in price.

Carol forsees emu becoming as popular as turkey. She said, "When emu are raised 10 acres of land, 9,000 pounds of meat can be produced compared to only 500 pounds of beef raised on the same amount of land."


