Movement of ready-to-cook whole birds was slow to moderate and generally disappointing. Seller offerings were adequate to fully adequate. Live supplies were mostly moderate; weights varied in a range of light to heavy, mostly light to desirable. Processing schedules were very heavy. Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 48 to 59 cents. Trade sentiment remained about steady. In the parts complex wings were well cleared to short.
