Live supplies were mostly moderate, weights were in a full range of light to heavy, but were desirable at most plants Processing schedules were very heavy Less than trucklot asking prices were unchanged at 48 to 59 cents Trade sentiment was steady to fully steady. In the parts complex, wings remained in a range of tight to short. Legs and leg quarters were adequate and were clearing well. Breast items were less freely available, but runained fully adequate for current needs.




