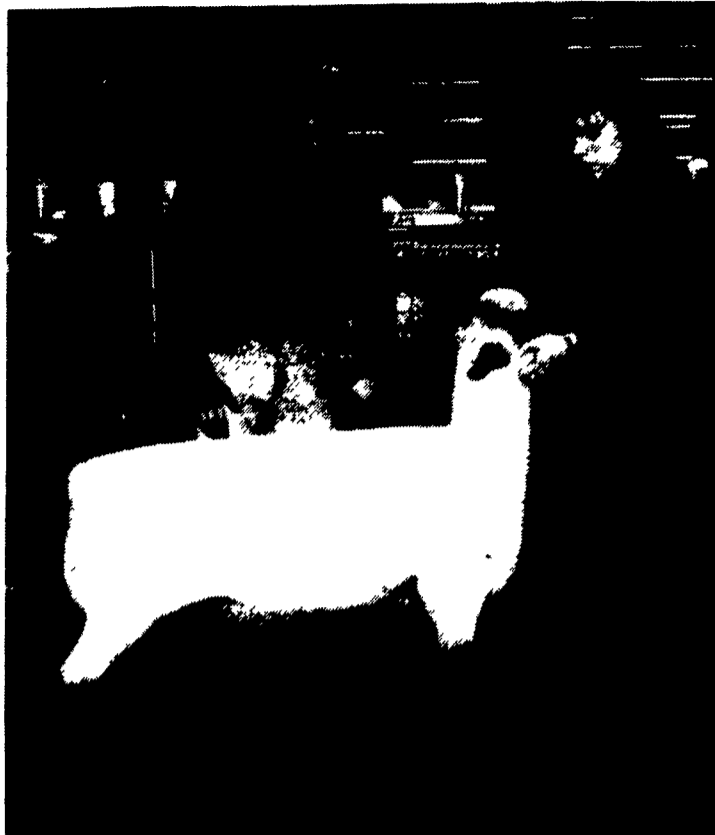

# Agribusinesses Honored At Farm Show

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — State Agriculture Secretary Boyd E. Wolff has announced the names of firms winning the 1995 Agribusiness Achievement Awards. The awards were presented at the Farm Show Dinner held on January 7 in Harrisburg.

"These awards recognize companies that contribute to the industry that employs so many Pennsylvanians and produces the highest quality food throughout the Commonwealth," Wolff said.

The awards were made in two categories. The small company category included companies with gross annual sales under \$5,000,000. The large company category included companies with gross annual sales over \$5,000,000.

The winner of the 1995

Agribusiness Achievement Award in the small company category is Heritage Wine Cellars, Inc. of North East, Erie County. Heritage Wine Cellars was founded in 1978, but the family traditions of wine making and agriculture go back to 1833. Heritage has received awards both nationally and internationally for its high quality native American wines. The company has experienced a 130 percent growth rate during each of the past two years.

The selection of an award winner in the large company category ended in a tie vote between Oglevee Ltd., Inc., of Connelville, Fayette County, and Farmers Pride, Inc., of Fredericksburg, Lebanon County.

Oglevee Ltd. was founded in the 1880s in Connelville as a nursery operation. Over the years it diversified into retail vegetable and greenhouse flower production. The company has grown to become the largest producer of cutting geraniums in North America. Oglevee Ltd. currently offers commercial growers the widest variety of colors and types of zonal, ivy and regal geranium cuttings available.
