

## Wilson Elected Chairman Of Institute's Finance Committee

The Pennsylvania Auctioneers Association was founded by a group of successful businessmen who believe in the future and potential of the auction method of marketing.

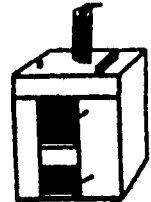

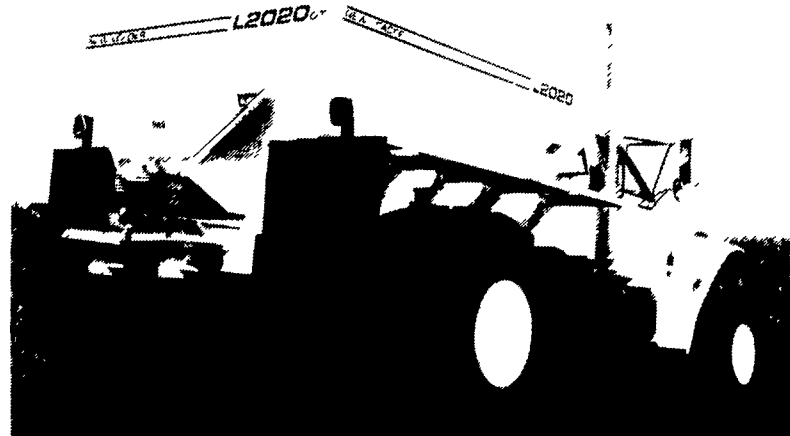
