OKLAHOMA NATIONAL STOCKYARDS WEEKLY CATTLE SUMMARY

Compared to last week: Feeder steers over 800 lbs \$1.00-\$2.00 lower, 700-800 lbs steady. Stocker steers and steer calves \$1.00-\$2.00 higher. Feeder heifers and heifer calves steady to \$1.00 lower. Demand good for feeder cattle, very good for stockers and steer calves, rather light for heifer calves. Price spread between heavy feeders and light feeders is beginning to open up to a more normal price differential. This due to the inability to turn the larger feeders as fats before May. The month of May is pegged to the June CME slaughter cattle contract. Quality of supply average to attractive. Weigh-ups average

Flesh condition of feeders off wheat medium to slightly fleshy. Several stockers in thin flesh. Slaughter cows steady to \$1.00 higher. Slaughter bulls steady. Demand good from packers and replacement buyers. 305 cows and bulls sold with 55 percent to packers. Receipts this week 6,950; last week 4,534; last year 4,783. Supply consisted of 81 percent yearlings over 600 lbs.; 15 percent calves under 600 lbs.; 4 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.


