Agronomy Guide Available

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.) — The 1994-1995 Penn State Agronomy Guide is available and has new information on weed management and control, as well as keys for identifying common grassy and broadleaved weed seedlings in Pennsylvania.

The 214-page publication contains detailed information on corn, grain sorghum, soybeans for grain, small grains and forage crops. Included are sections on pest management, soil fertility management, crop storage and erosion control.

Contributors to the guide include faculty and extension staff in Penn State's departments of agronomy, entomology, plant pathology and agricultural economics and rural sociology. Government agencies and businesses also contributed information.
