February Milk \$14.41

ALEXANDRIA, Va. -- Middle Atlantic Order Market Administrator Rex F. Lothrop has announced a Class I milk price of \$14.41 per hundredweight for February 1995.

This price is down 48 cents from January and is \$1.13 below last February's Class I price.

Mr. Lothrop announced a Class III milk price of \$11.46 per hundredweight for December 1994 and a Class III-A price of \$10.25 per hundredweight for the month. The Class III price was down 48 cents from the previous month, while the Class III-A price decreased 23

The February 1995 Class I price and the December 1994 Class III price are based on the December 1994 Minnesota-Wisconsin manufacturing milk price of \$11.38 per hundredweight at a 3.5 percent butterfat content.

The December 1994 butterfat price was 67.43 cents per pound, down 6.27 cents from November. The December skim milk price per hundredweight was \$9.43.

The USDA reported that the wholesale price of Grade A butter at Chicago for December was 65.52 cents per pound on the mercantile exchange and the Central States nonfat dry milk price was \$1.0686 per pound.




