Now's The Time To Join Corn Growers

STATE COLLEGE (Centre Co.) — The Pennsylvania Master Corn Growers Association (PMCGA) is pleased to announce continuing support for the Membership Incentive Program (MIP) that is being conducted in conjunction with several cooperating seed companies.

The MIP, with seed corn company sponsorship, will entitle any corn grower who plants at least five acres of corn to a free bag of seed corn (standard size) with a three-year membership in PMCGA/ NCGA.

This program applies to all three-year memberships, new

or renewal.

To participate, simply complete the membership form included in this issue of *Corn Talk* and indicate the brand of seed corn you would like to try.

Remember, the theme of the program is "Try Something New." Growers who sign up will receive a free bag of seed from the company chosen by PMCGA. The grower will make the ultimate decision about which hybrid he will receive in consultation with the local seed corn dealer for the company selected. PMCGA will send the names and addresses by brand chosen to the appropriate seed corn com-



pany's statewide contact person, and that person will contact the grower.

Locally, those who sign up will be helping to support PMCGA's activities, such as *Corn Talk*, the annual Pennsylvania Crops Conference, and local com promotion activities.


The PMCGA board of directors have also developed a membership program in cooperation with DuPont. This program is targeted at recruiting new members of PMCGA. Any Pennsylvania corn grower who joins PMCGA for three years for the first time is eligible to receive a free four-acre sample of Accent herbicide (\$100 retail value).

The offer is available to anyone who grows more than 100 acres of corn, has not been a member of PMCGA before, and who has not received an Accent sample in the past. There is a limit of one sample per farming operation. In addition, new three-year members can elect to participate in the PMCGA Membership Incentive Program and elect to try a free unit of seed corn from one of the participating companies on the membership application.
