

## Cedar Crest Equipment Holds Open House

NORTH CORNWALL (Lebanon Co.) — Hundreds of people attended a three-day open house of Cedar Crest Equipment held at the Lebanon Fairgrounds this week as part of a way of showing appreciation for patronage and to let people examine new and used equipment that may help them with their farming operations.

Feed mixers for totally mixed rations (TMR) by different manufacturers were on display, as well as ventilation fans, automatic or

manual side-wall curtain systems, hay, straw and paper choppers, round bale choppers, grain and meal storage bins, elevator systems, small mills, and dairy stall bedding systems for cow comfort were on display in the large convention barn at the fairgrounds.

Along with a provided lunch meal, visitors also were able to attend a free silo unloader clinic and attend a last day equipment auction.
