

## **4-H Horse Shows Require Rabies Vaccination**

Penn State Cooperative Extension has released a reminder for rabies vaccination requirements for horses, ponies or mules participating in 4-H activities.

According to the extension service, all horses and ponies entered in 4-H horse shows, open horse shows sponsored by 4-H, or used in rides at public events must be vaccinated for rabies at least one month before the event. Revaccination is required each year.

Vaccinations are required for all horses over six months of age. In addition, mules that might be included in rides, public displays, or projects must be inoculated. Finally, ponies used in 4-H fundraising pony rides also must be vaccinated.

Horse owners can present a form signed and dated by a veterinarian stating that the horse was vaccinated, or owners may sign a statement when they arrive at a show indicating their horse has


