

If you look at this year's tobacco pricing, there was not much fluctuation - this is what the tobacco companies want. Tobacco prices at a steady level is not a problem if it were \$1.35/Lb. and each buyer gets his share at the same price level with even pricing from start to finish.

A thought for the Farmers: The tobacco company decides, before the auction starts, how much tobacco they will buy out of the auction barn - then they will divide out orders to whomever. Same way on country buying. Also, they decide the price before auction starts, or try to. When dealing with these people, we need to use common sense.
