Outstanding Farm Bureau Women's Program Chosen

OCEAN CITY, Md. — Frederick County Farm Bureau Women's Committee was named the Outstanding Farm Bureau Women's Program for the State in 1994 recently at the 79th Annual Maryland Farm Bureau Convention. Shirley Zimmerman Chair of the Women's Committee, accepted the award at the Convention held in Ocean City in December. Frederick County Farm Bureau received the prestigious Outstanding County Farm Bureau Trophy, awarded to a County that has achieved program excellence in eight areas. The Women's Committee is one of those eight areas.

Gold Star Awards were presented to Frederick County Farm Bureau in the areas of Membership, Public Affairs, National

Affairs, Information, Women's Committee, Young Farmers, Discussion Group, and Service to Member. Eight other counties also received eight Gold Stars and were in the running for the top honor.

Membership in Frederick County Farm Bureau exceeds 1,200, according to Don Easterday, Frederick County Farm Bureau secretary. Maryland Farm Bureau has more than 14,000 members. While Frederick is the state's largest dairy county, "all commodities in Frederick County are well represented, including dairy, sheep, pork, and the orchards," according to Shirley Zimmerman.

In addition to Mrs. Zimmerman as chairperson, other officers of the County Women's Committee include vice-chair, Louise Stup;

recording secretary and corresponding secretary, Lisa Gaver; and treasurer, Louise Ediger. Mrs. Marianne Browning is the chaplain and historian, and Peggy Garst serves as women's information director. There are five districts in Frederick County, and three members from each district are directors, appointed for three year terms.

1994 was a busy year for the Women's Committee as they helped promote and activate the entire Farm Bureau program throughout the county. A legislative day held in conjunction with Pomona Grange, Women's Day in Annapolis to meet with county delegates, Ag Week at the mall, and the Farm Queen contest were all annual events the ladies participated in. The women were also active in the state sponsored Ag in the Classroom workshop for teachers. They would like to establish a similar program at the county level.

A number of exceptional new outreach programs were also implemented by the group during the year. A farm tour seminar, sponsored in conjunction with Maryland Farm Bureau, titled "Beyond the Hayride" brought approximately 65 participants from throughout the state to the 4-H Camp Center to explore new ideas for on-farm tours for the public. The first Farm Safety Camp for Kids was another program the ladies helped sponsor.

Jane Smith, chairperson of the Farm Bureau Safety Committee, organized the event, which brought approximately 60 youth to the camp for talks on subjects ranging from equipment safety to sun protection. It was also the first year that the Frederick County Farm Bureau had an information booth at the Great Frederick Fair. It was successful, and Mrs. Zimmerman said the ladies were "looking forward to going back" next year.

Other highlights of the Women's activities throughout the year include sharing their enthusiasm with a display booth with the theme "Partners in Progress" at the Extension Office's Farm City Day, participation in the fundraising efforts of the "Halfacre Club" to acquire more land for the 4-H Camp Center, and volunteering their time at the Farm Museum at Rose Hill Manor. The Women also donated \$500 to the Christmas Cash for Kids program, which helps needy children. Members also sold food at the weekly hay sale sponsored by Frederick County Farm Bureau.
