The U.S. tour follows the national officer team's return from a two-week visit to Japan sponsored by Mitsui & Co. (USA), Inc., as a special project of the National FFA Foundation, Inc. The tour to Japan provides the officers with a better understanding of international trade relations and its importance to American agriculture.


