

Boyd Cook Retires From Dairy Industry

HAGERSTOWN (Maryland)
— After serving dairy farmers for 37 years, Mid-America Dairymen, Inc., cooperative division manager and industry leader Boyd M. Cook has retired.

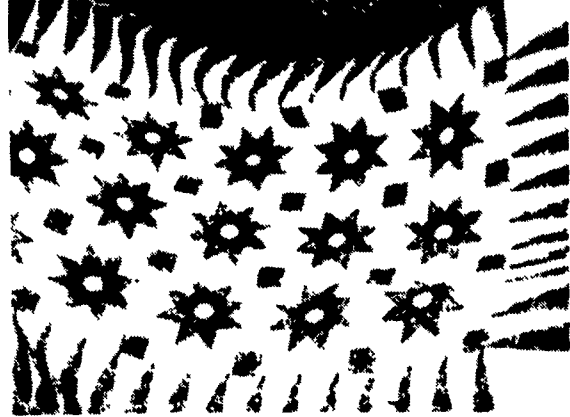
He was feted at a "toast and roast" retirement dinner February 11 at the Hagerstown Ramada Inn, attended by more than 200 cooperative employees, directors, industry associates, family and friends. Since 1988, Cook has Served as manager of the former Middle Atlantic Division of Dairymen, Inc. The division merged with

Mid-America Dairymen in September, 1994. Cook began his dairy cooperative leadership career in 1958, when he left management of the family dairy farm in Delaware to become a field representative for Maryland Cooperative Milk Producers, Inc. In 1962 he was named head field representative; and in 1974, Cook became the Baltimore-based cooperative's assis-

tant manager and secretary. Prior to his appointment as manager in 1988, the cooperative had merged with Dairymen, Inc., as its Middle Atlantic Division. Born and raised on the family farm near Wilmington, Delaware, Cook graduated from Middletown High School in 1948. He enlisted (Turn to Page A39)
