

It's all controlled from your tractor seat! Vermeer R-24 TwinRake hydraulically lifts to start the folding sequence.

A 2-stage hydraulic system slides telescoping stabilizer/linkage arms along the tongue, drawing the front-folding baskets together.



After the outside baskets are completely folded, they are locked into position on the center post and lifted for transport. It's that simple. You're ready to roll, with just an 8'8" transport width ... in seconds!

Vermeer Side-Delivery Rakes: Extra Muscle & Rakes That Hustle!

Rugged Vermeer R-9 Side-Delivery Rakes really hustle, no matter what the conditions. Choose ground or hydraulic-driven. Rubber-mounted tines (100) give you plenty of positive pickup action (especially important with higher speeds and heavier crops). Sweep it all up — 9-1/2' wide — with a minimum 25 hp tractor.



Vermeer Hydraulic-Fold FingerWheel Rakes!

Large, fluffy windrows for big bales & tight-fisted budgets. Soft, gentle raking action that brings home the leaves.




AND, THEY'RE EASY TO OPERATE!

- Dual rake assemblies respond quickly to contour changes with a smooth floating, pivoting action. Operating speeds up to 14 mph.
- Simple center-mounted fold mechaniem hydraulically raises rakes for transport.
- Shock-absorbing suspension springs reduce impact from joits and excessive ground pressure.

HD sealed roller bearings for longer wear, less maintenance.

- No need for gears or sprockets! Simple turnbuckle varies fingerwheel angles to handle various crops and conditions.
- Flexible, tightly spaced times (40 per wheel) gently sweep crop toward the center, into light, fluffy windrows.



THREE DIFFERENT SIZES TO CHOOSE FROM: WR20 (6 fingerwheels), rakes a 17'8" to 19'8" swath; WR22 (10 fingerwheels), sweeps 20' to 22' across; WR24 (12 fingerwheels), sweeps 23'6" to 25'6" across. All three units require just a minimum 20hp or 25hp tractor.
