CHICAGO, Ill. - Food communicators attending a recent International Food and Lifestyles Media Conference got a taste of social and safety issues that affect meat purchasing, thanks to two sessions sponsored by the National Live Stock and Meat Board.

More than 80 members of the food and lifestyle press and free lance writers attended the conference, held in Las Vegas, Nev., recently.

The Meat Board provided speakers who explored factors in two areas that affect today's meat shopping patterns: food safety and consumer trends that are taking place in this country. Trends discussed include increasing ethnic diversity, an aging population and the rise of women in the workplace. According to Susan Parenti, assistant director of Meat Board Test Kitchens and Editorial Services, information provided will be highly useful to food editors.

"Food safety and social trends are areas of great interest, both to the media and the general popula-tion," Parenti said. "Within the meat industry, we understand the significance of these factors. Now food editors also have a better grasp of what the data means, in terms of the food we purchase and meals we eat."




