

Satellite Program To Focus On Alzheimer's Disease

COLLEGEVILLE (Montgomery Co.) — Nearly four million Americans, including former President Ronald Reagan, have Alzheimer's disease. Caregivers can find themselves experiencing a range of reactions to often unsettling new behaviors.

A video satellite program, "Coping with Alzheimer's: Challenging Behaviors," scheduled March 24 from 11 a.m. to 1.15 p.m. at the Montgomery County 4-H Center in Collegeville is designed to help families recognize, understand, and adapt to the changes in behavior they may see in their relative with the disease.

The program is sponsored by University of Wisconsin-Extension and University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics in cooperation with Penn State University.

Program participants will learn:

- How to assess the possible causes for challenging behaviors which may result from Alzheimer's.
- How to identify coping strategies and approaches to handle the challenging behaviors created by the disease.
