**Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary**

Receipts: This Week: 16,925 Last Week: 11,712 Last Year: 12,469

Compared to last week: Feeder cattle steady to 2.00 lower with greatest declines over 800 lbs; however buyers very sensitive to excess flesh and these kind 1.00-3.00 lower than comparable types last week. Demand for feeders moderate as buyers more selective than recent weeks. This selectivity due as much to nearly full feedlots as the negative CME futures close on Monday. Stocker steers and heifers fully steady. Stocker cattle still benefiting from the usual bout of spring fever and enjoy excellent demand. Quality of supply plain to average. Weigh-ups average to full, few gaunt. Flesh condition of feeders continues to deteriorate with most in fairly abundant to maximum flesh as well as an increase in lot fed cattle; few in medium to slightly thin flesh but this a definite minority. Bulk of stocker weight cattle in thinner flesh conditions. Rains began Sunday night and continue through Tuesday with 2-4 inches so far. Slaughter cows and bulls steady to 1.00 lower. Demand from packers moderate to good with wide spread buyer participation. Total of 306 cows and bulls sold with 60 percent to packers. Receipts this week 16,925; last week 11,712; last year 12,469. Supply consisted of 83 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 15 percent calves under 600 lbs; 2 percent

cows and bulls.

Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parentheses.
