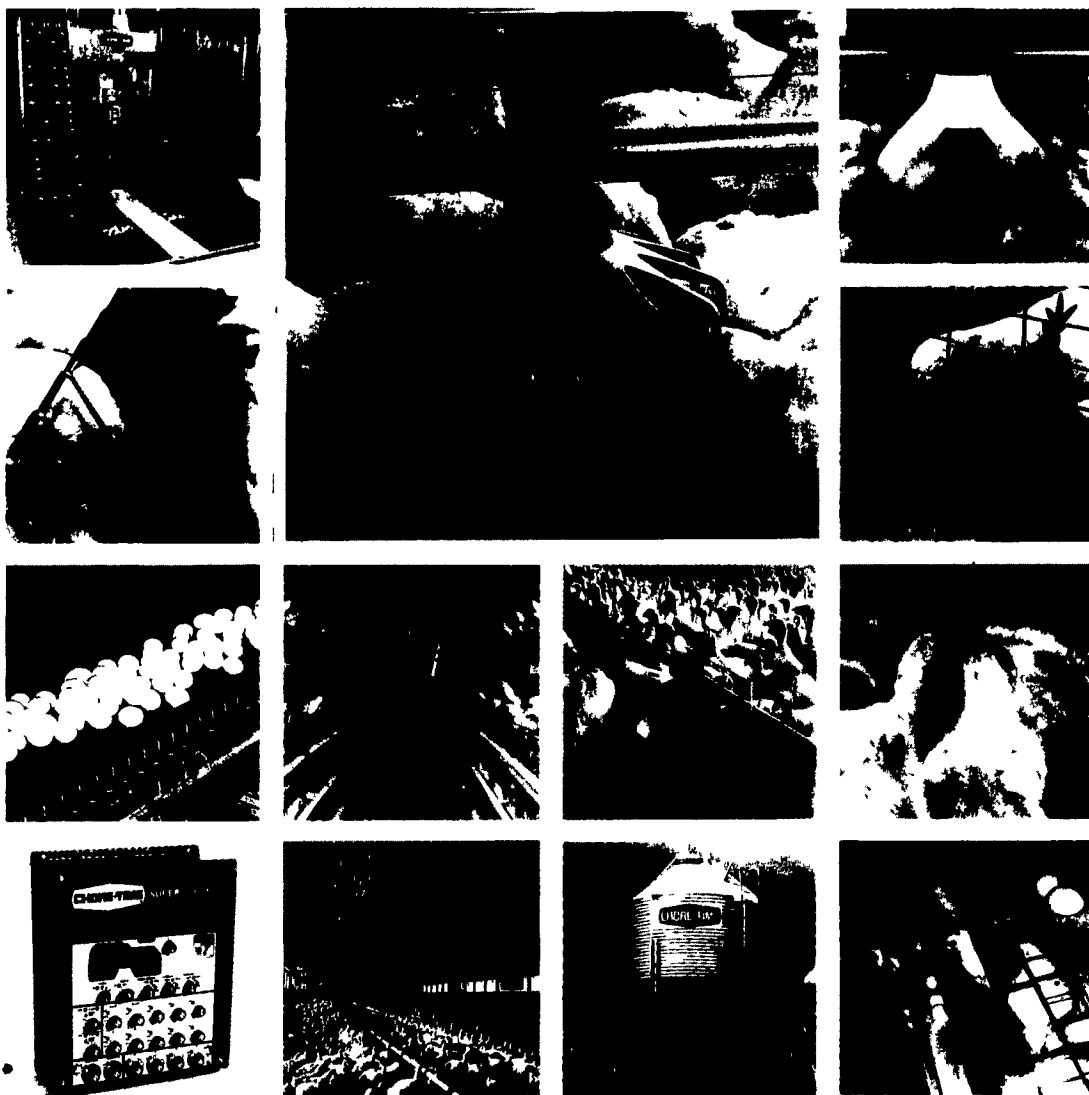
**Dauphin County Offers Youth Development Program**

 The Enhancing Ethical Leadership Training is free and open to both teens and adults, male and female.

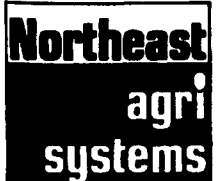
