

Quilters' Heritage Celebration Releases Schedule

LANCASTER (Lancaster Co.) — The eighth annual Quilters' Heritage Celebration will be held at the Lancaster Host Resort and Conference Center April 5-9.

The Celebration is packed with exhibits and displays from every type of quilting project, equipment and materials imaginable to contests, workshops, and fashion show.

Registration for the quilt exhibits and merchant mall is \$6 a day.

If you wish to take classes, registration is \$12, which includes a tote bag and entry to quilt exhibits and merchant mall. A 3-hour class fee is \$25 and a 6-hour class fee is \$45.

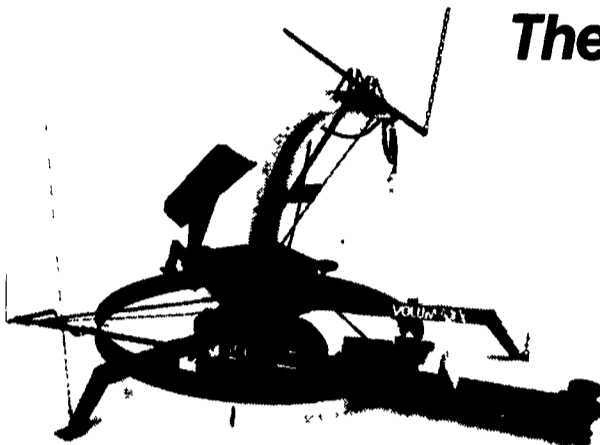

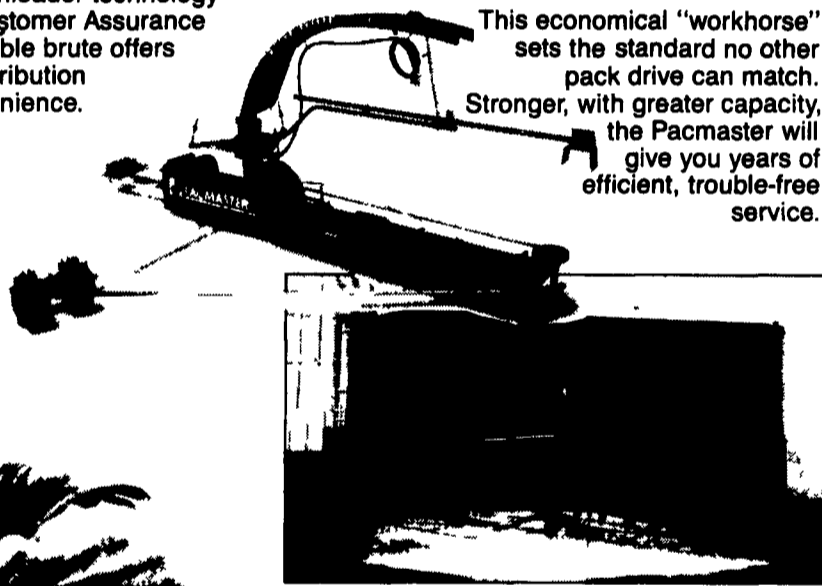

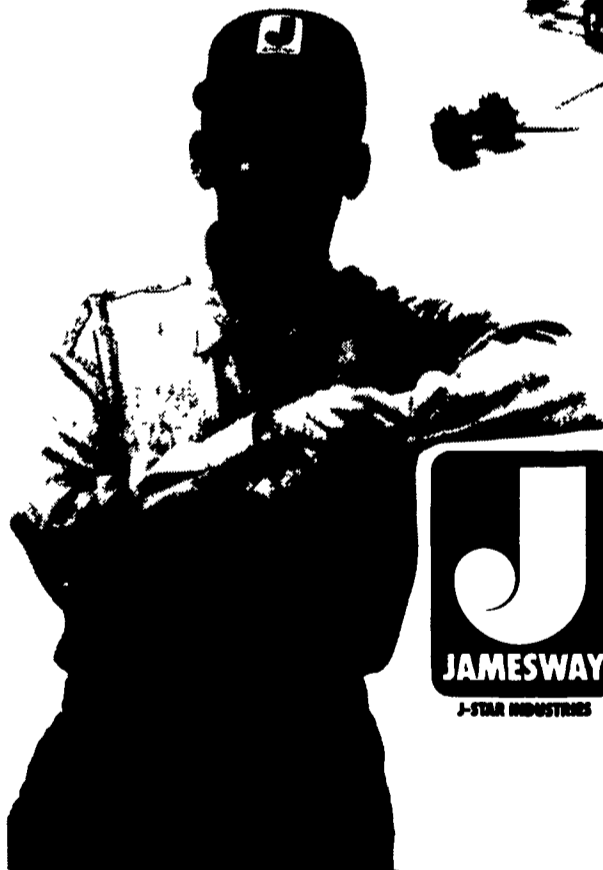
