We appreciate those who send in recipes regularly but hope they understand that we cannot print all of them. We do not keep the full addresses of those who ask questions or send in recipes. We do not have the time to send personal replies.

The reader also wanted to know how we select feature stories. We are always looking for ideas. We want our readers to send in suggestions for features or people who they think will make an interesting subject.






