Ag Society Honors Duffield

CLAYTON, N.J.—David Duffield, owner and operator of Duffield's Farm Market in Sewell, was recently honored by the New Jersey Agricultural Society with its 1995 Agricultural Marketing Award at the state agricultural convention in Atlantic City.

Duffield was recognized, along with his wife Mary, by the Society For Excellence in Marketing, according to Ray Blew, president of the society.

Presenting the award on behalf of the society was Jerry Frecon, agricultural agent with Rutgers Cooperative Extension of Gloucester County. Frecon not only acknowledged David Duftield but also his wife Mary, sons David and Dan (in charge of production and harvesting), daughter Debbie Grelli, and daughters-inlaw Tracy and Ruth Ann (management of the farm market, deli and bake shop).

Said Frecon, "Dave started farming on his own in 1953 and after marrying Mary in 1960 began selling produce off a small stand in front of their house. This small stand grew to a modest 36-foot by 40-foot open building and then later to a fully enclosed airconditioned market with cold storage, grading area, and dry storage. As the market expanded, a bake shop, full-line delicatessen and kitchen have brought it to its current size."

Frecon also said, "Outside the market is a modern spacious parking lot, a large plastic house for bedding plant sales, small wooden gazebo for gift sales, a petting zoo with a variety of animals, a fencedin picnic area, and a large shaded area for festivals and fairs run both dependently, or independently with the Duffields' business.

"The Duffield market is a tremendous asset to the community" said Frecon "concurrently, with the market 20 to 30 acres of strawberries and peas are u-picked in the field in May and June, and a large field of pumpkins is u-picked in a staged location in September and October."

Said Frecon, "The Duffields have a unique agribusiness that employs from 50 to 100 people. not including many friends and community families involved in festivals, hay rides, Easter Bunny trips, and much more.'

Frecon recognized David Duffield for the tremendous level of knowledge and talent it takes to not only manage a diversified marketing operation but also the ability to grow a wide variety of fruits and vegetables on approximately 200 acres of wind-swept sandy loam and loamy sand soils in rapidly growing Washington Township.


