Oklahoma National Stockyards Weekly Cattle Summary

Compared to last week: Feeder steers 2.00-4.00 lower; stocker steers steady to 2.00 lower. Feeder heifers over 700 lbs weak to 2.00 lower; feeder and stocker heifers under 700 lbs 2.00-4.00 lower. Demand moderate for steers; light to moderate for heifers. Quality of the supply average to attractive with continued liberal supply of Brahma cross. Conditions comparable to last week with flesh varying from slightly thin thru moderately fleshy. Weigh condition mostly average. Slaughter cows steady to 1.00 lower. Slaughter bulls steady to 1.00 higher. Packer demand moderate at best. 230 cows and bulls sold

with 55 percent to packers. Receipts this week 9,575; last week 8,448; last year 15,619. Supply consisted of 83 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 15 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 2 percent cows and bulls. Prices follow with weighted average weight and price in parenthesis.

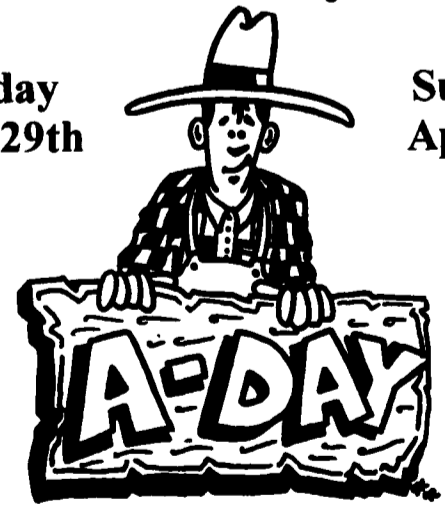
