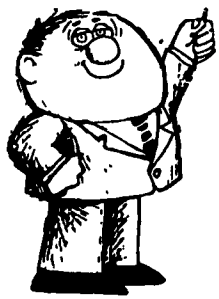

Meeting Focuses On Profiles

member producers. CEO Phil Dukas reported total DHIA enrollment for the year was up 25,000 cows, to 4.7 million. Using a report card format, he gave the DHIA System high marks in many areas, but stressed the need to strengthen the data network and new product development.

Treasurer Buddy Nichols stated finances were stable, with a surplus of \$59,000.

Dr. Dean Plowman, chief administrator of the USDA-Agricultural Research Service stressed the need for continued research support in the dairy industry.

Wim Rossing of MAG-DLO, Glen Lucas of Erie in Columbia DHIS, George Turner of Bou-Matic and Michael Tomaszewski of Texas DHIA rounded out the technology symposium program, offering various insights into the future of the dairy industry. Consolidations and joint ventures were the major topics off the convention floor.

Minnesota and Cornell DRPCs have announced their plans to close by the end of the year. Some DHIA mergers have occurred, such as the Heart of America, with others in discussion.

Tulare DHIA became the first new DHIA Affiliate since the

removal of state barriers. And while a number of DHIA labs have consolidated, a similar number of new labs have entered the System.

National DHIA serves as a liaison for the DHIA System with other dairy industry organizations. The DHIA System provides dairy management information systems for the dairy industry which aid dairy producers' profitability.

The DHIA System is comprised of 32 Affiliate DHIA's, 45 central milk analysis labs and nine dairy processing centers. The DHIA System includes over 2,000 employees nationwide and has a membership of over 50,000 dairy producers.
