

## HAPPY BIRTHDAY, ROBERT B!

he founder of The Old Farmer's Almanac, Robert Bailey Thomas, was born in Grafton, Massachusetts on April 24, 1766 – 229 years ago. The first of 12 editors and 23 publishers to concern themselves with The Old Farmer's Almanac, now in its 203rd anniversary issue, Robert B. put out 54 editions before he died in 1846. The Old was added to the title from 1832 to 1835, and then permanently from 1848, to reduce con-

fusion with competing almanacs. Now collector's items, the old issues still crop up in attics, backhouses, and barns around New England. The original issue cost sixpence (about nine cents).

black pepper, to taste


lemon slices for garnish




