Wholesale Fruit Growers, Shippers Sought For Directory

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.) — To promote Pennsylvania's tree fruit industry, Agriculture Secretary Charles C. Brosius is seeking the names of wholesale fruit growers, packers and shippers to be included in a new directory.

In the past, retail fruit growers have been given the opportunity to be listed in the "Consumer's Guide to Pennsylvania Farm Markets." However, in keeping with Gov. Tom Ridge's promise to promote Pennsylvania's leading industry, Brosius said he believed it appropriate to create a new directory for wholesale fruit growers, packers, and shippers.


"Buyers could use this booklet as a guide to some of the best tree fruit in the nation," Brosius said. The directory will list whole-


The directory will list wholesale fruit growers, packers, and shippers of apples, peaches, nectarines, pears, tart and sweet cherries, plums, and other tree fruit.
