Compared to Monday of last week: Feeder and stocker steers 2.00-3.00 higher; heifers 1.00-2.00 higher. Demand very good for feeder steers, moderate for heifers. Excellent demand noted for last of the old crop yearling stocker steers. Attitudes much better with optimism replacing the pessimistic views of the past month. Quality of supply average thru attractive but conditions considerably less attractive to buyers than last several weeks. Feeder cattle in typical May wheat flesh and many cattle in slightly fleshy to maximum flesh condition. Weigh-ups average to many full. Bulk supply was feeder steers and heifers off graze-out wheat. Slaughter cows 1.00-2.00 lower. Slaughter bulls 2.00 lower. Demand moderate at lower levels. 370 cows and bulls sold. Receipts this week 9,100; last week 9,784; last year 13,599. Supply consisted of 89 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 9 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 4 percent cows and bulls.




