ance, consistency and flavor and creativity. A \$250 check goes to the winner of this contest.

The third contest is the "Greatest Cocoa Cake Contest." A \$500 award will be given to the winner of the chocolate cake contest. The layered cake must be made from scratch, frosted, and Hershey Cocoa must be used in the recipe. A special incentive of \$250 will be awarded to a nonprofit organization that has the largest number of

participants (minimum of 25 individual entries to qualify) entering this contest. The cakes must be entered before 1:30 p.m. on Saturday, May 27 and the event will be held at the Pavilion area of the fairgrounds.

For all three of the special food contests, the recipes must accompany the entry.

As with most fairs in Pennsylvania, there will be competition for Youth, 4-H and FFA, as well as the open class competition

already mentioned. There will also be beef cattle, sheep, potbellied pigs, goats, poultry, and rabbit competition.

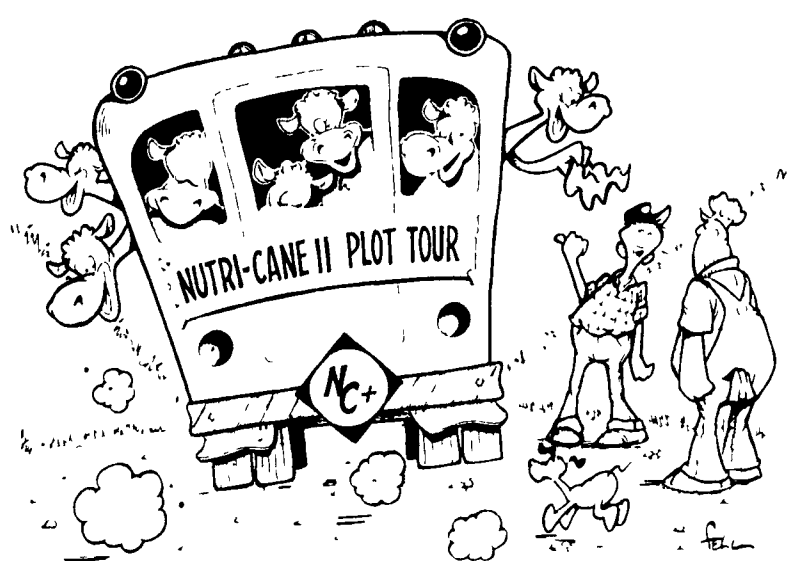
