Prices were unchanged to lower for the large sizes in the Midwest and Northeast, unchanged for mediums, and unchanged for all sizes elsewhere. The market tone remained barely steady to weak for large and extra-large, and generally steady for

mediums. Demand into retail channels was mixed, mostly moderate, and decreased daily unless features enhanced movement. Supplies of the large sizes were at least adequate and available, and mediums were tight to sometimes adequate. Breaking stock supplies were adequate for the irregular, but mostly fair demand, and the undertone was about steady. Live hen offerings continued at least adequate. 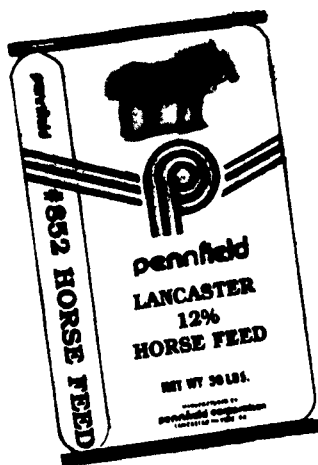
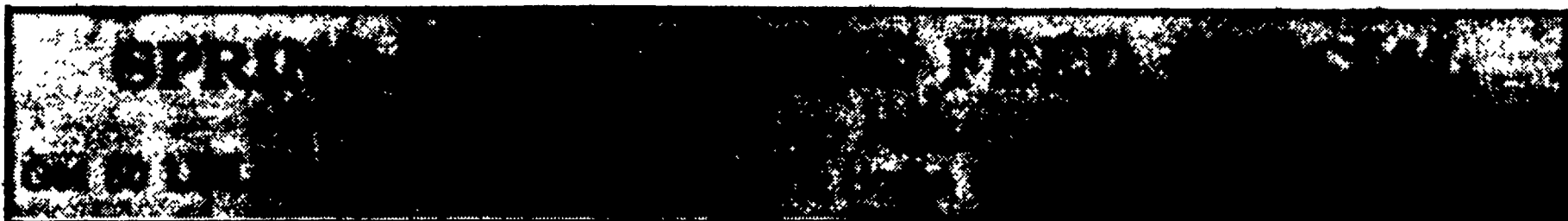

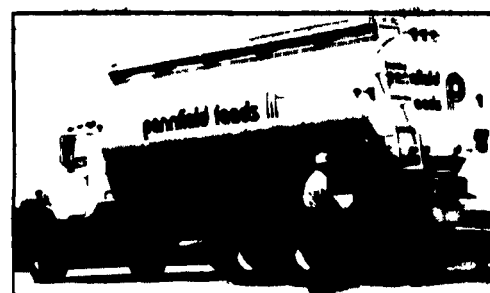
