Aaron Gable, son of Berneta and Brad Gable, was presented with the association's George W. Snyder Award, and the Sewickley Trophy, for his success in showing a Guernsey to place as champion of the youth division show at the 1995 Pennsylvania Farm Show.

In addition, the farm received the John Brachman Award for showing the grand champion Guernsey of the 1995 Farm Show.

In production awards, Trotacre Farm was honored for having the highest-average production herd for milk, milkfat and protein, and the top individual cow for milk and protein production.

The high-producing Trotacre herd consists of 52 cows averaging 17,535 pounds of milk, 797 pounds of fat, and 602 pounds of protein.

The farm's high producing cow was Trotacre Fayette Loretta, with 28,376 pounds of milk, 1,110 pounds fat, and 909 pounds protein.

Rutter Brothers, of York, was honored for having the highest milkfat-producing cow among the association's membership. Rutter Brothers Future's Lively made 21,212 pounds of milk, 1,120 pounds of milkfat, and 681 pounds of protein.
