As of presstime, 130 children were signed up, according to a spokesperson for the farm child safety groups. While registration is

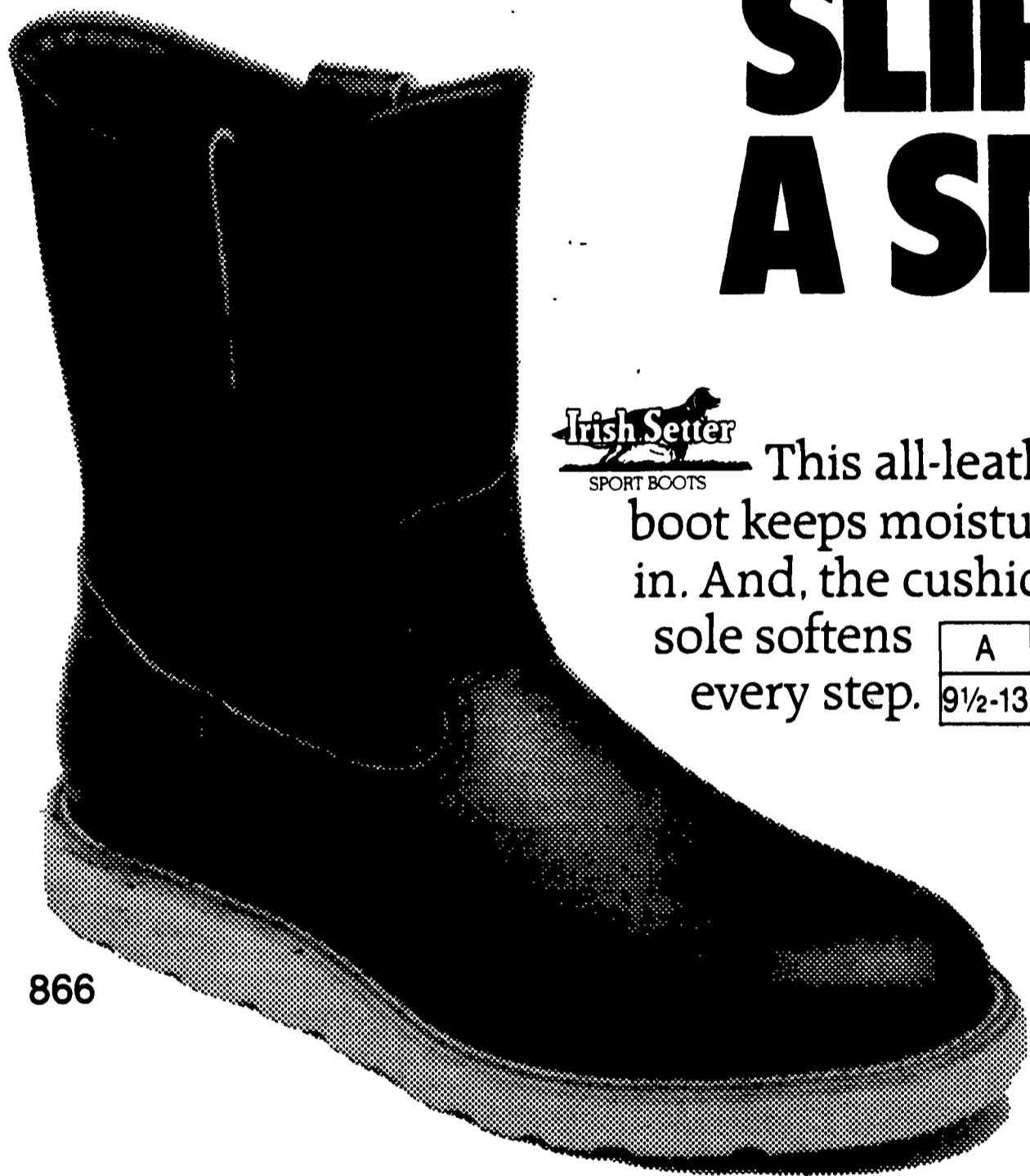
limited, a waiting list is available for those who still want to register. Call (800) 822-0769 for more information.
