Weekly Cattle Summary Compared to last Monday: Feeder and stocker steers steady to 2.00higher. Feeder and stocker heifers 1.00-3.00 higher. Demand moderate for steers, very good for heifers. Feeder steer demand good early but only moderate in afternoon. Small

supply of new crop calves sold to good

demand. Buyers found no relief in weigh-

ups or flesh conditions; however quality of

supply was improved from last week.

Feeder cattle weigh-ups average to many

full; cattle in medium plus to heavy flesh. Quality average with modest end attractive.

Slaughter cows and bulls steady. Packer demand moderate. Total of 600 cows and bulls sold with 30 percent replacements. Receipts this week 10,700; last week 7,537; last year 11,618.

Supply consisted of 83 percent yearlings over 600 lbs; 11 percent calves and light yearlings under 600 lbs; 6 percent cows and bulls.
