## Farm Safety, Occupational Health Board Appointed

HARRISBURG (Dauphin Co.)—In an effort to reduce farmrelated injuries and fatalities, Agriculture Secretary Charles Brosius recently chaired the first meeting of the Pennsylvania Farm Safety & Occupational Health Advisory Board.

The Farm Safety and Occupational Health (FSOH) Act of 1994 empowered the state Agriculture Secretary to appoint a 13-member board to monitor farm safety in Pennsylvania and make recommendations to incorporate its voluntary educational strategies.

"Agriculture is the number one industry of Pennsylvania, with \$3.67 billion in cash receipts and nearly \$40 billion in related economic activity," Brosius said.
"However, agriculture is also ranked the most hazardous industry in the nation."

Brosius signed a memorandum of understanding with Lamartine Hood, dean of Penn State's Col-

lege of Agricultural Sciences, to lead the way in developing and implementing a comprehensive farm health and safety program to benefit Pennsylvania farmers, their families and their employees.

"We intend to maximize our resources and work together with the farm community, insurance and university specialists to improve the safety efforts of our rural citizens," Brosius said. -


